It is suggested that your child spends some of their time studying during the holidays to help ensure that they are as well prepared as possible for starting year 11:

English

- Re-read, in anticipation of September, Lord of the Flies and Jekyll and Hyde. Your child could listen to the audio books on line whilst they have the text in front of them, this is a really effective use of time and a good way to revise.
