Dear Parent/Carer

We have been deeply saddened to learn that Mrs Becky King, our long-term member of staff and friend, died yesterday after a very short illness. Mrs King will not be known to all parents but, for some, she played a huge role in the care and support of Tudor Grange Academy Worcester students. Her presence will be significantly missed by our community. Naturally, our thoughts are with Mrs King's family and friends to whom we pass our deepest condolences.

The teaching staff were told after school yesterday and students have been informed in their College groups this morning. Additional support has been made available in school today. We are concerned that as we break up for half-term today, we are unable to provide the support for the children we would like to next week. To that end, I encourage you to please talk to your child about this and explain that it is absolutely normal for them to feel a range of emotions, and they may be quieter than normal.

We will be making arrangements as a school to remember Mrs King after half-term and will be in contact in due course with further details regarding this.
