### Coronavirus update

Thank you for your support and understanding in helping us in our endeavours to keep the Academy free from coronavirus, our first priority is always the welfare of the Tudor Grange community. Further to my previous communications, I wanted to provide you with an update on our current situation and how the Academy is responding to this. We are reviewing all upcoming trips, visits and events and will inform parents of any changes as necessary.

Currently there are no confirmed cases of coronavirus connected with the Academy that we are aware of.

We continue to monitor this highly dynamic situation and follow the advice provided by Public Health England and the NHS. You are already aware that we have heightened our own hygiene measures in school and have briefed students on NHS guidance. We have identified a dedicated medical isolation room should anyone develop symptoms while in school so we can help minimise contact with others.

We are also in the midst of contingency planning in case all schools are instructed to close for a period of time. These plans include the setting of work for students to complete whilst at home. Staff are receiving additional training to prepare for this eventuality and we will communicate details of how this will work should we need to move to this phase of delivery. For now, I would encourage you all to check that your child(ren) have strong internet access to use from home if needed and ensure that they can access their Show My Homework account, the online learning platform.

As a single point of contact, if you have any issues with accessing Show My Homework then please contact [office@worcs.tgacademy.org.uk](mailto:office@worcs.tgacademy.org.uk) and the most appropriate member of staff will deal with your query.

For avoidance of doubt, in line with Public Health England advice, you should continue to send your child to school as normal so long as they have no flu like symptoms



Should anyone develop symptoms (a cough / high temperature / shortness of breath) they should follow the current Public Health England advice, which is to self-isolate. In this case, please call the Academy to inform us but do not attend for a period of seven days as advised by Government on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2020.


