Dear Parents and Carers and Students in Years 11 and 13

**RE: Arrangements for receiving GCSE Results on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2021 / A-level results on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2021**

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for receiving your GCSE/A-level results this summer. As you know, the results this year have been decided by the school, using a range of evidence collected throughout your courses.

Results will be available on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2021/ Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2021.

In an attempt to minimise the number of people on-site, maintain advised precautionary measures and reduce the risk of virus transmission, results will be sent electronically to your child's school email address.

#### **How can we access results electronically?**

The safest, fairest and fastest way to access results will be by logging onto your child's school email account, an example email address is [15jonesP@worcs.tgacademy.org.uk](mailto:15jonesP@worcs.tgacademy.org.uk). Please check before Thursday/Tuesday that your child is able to access their email address and contact the school if you need any support.

Results will be emailed to all students by 8.30 am on Thursday/Tuesday morning.

#### **We cannot/do not want to access results electronically, can my child come and collect them from the Academy?**

The Academy is operating a skeletal staff to support students in accessing results if they are unable to do so from home. To ensure that we are keeping students and staff safe, we are putting the following measures into place:

1. A one way system will be in operation. Pupils will need to use the pathway in front of the school to enter through the left hand side of the main entrance. Having collected results they will move through to the Hub and directed out of opposite side of the main entrance/ exit.

If there are more than 30 students collecting results at the time of arrival, pupils will be asked to wait.

2. Sanitising stations will be situated at entry and exit points.
3. By limiting the number of people on site at any given time, we are able to ensure that the site will not become over populated. Regrettably, this also means that parents are not able to accompany their child into the Academy to collect results but are able to access the car park and wait outside school for them.





## What can I do if I have any questions or queries following receipt of the results?

If you have any questions regarding the grade that you have been awarded, please speak to your College Leader.

## My child has questions about Post 16 / university destinations, will they be able to speak to someone?

Yes. The Leadership and 6<sup>th</sup> Form teams are available in the Hub to speak to students. Appointments will be available on the day upon request.

You do not need to be on-site to access this assistance as our phone lines will be open (01905 454627) and you can be directed to a member of the team.

If you have applied to study at TGAW sixth form, please ensure you confirm your place and courses on the day. If you have applied to study at TGAW and this is no longer your intention, please also let us know.

We ask that parents support the smooth running of this important day by going through this letter with your child.

We appreciate that these have been unprecedented times and have valued your on-going support. We wish every pupil the very best and will support them every step of the way over the coming days and weeks.
