The following celebrities started their journeys as apprentices before they achieved global fame.






Elvis Presley

Eric Clapton

Arguably one of the best guitarists ever, Eric Clapton completed a vocational course in stained glass design before turning to music.

The Mona Lisa is one of the most famous paintings in history – drawn by a former apprentice painter. The Italian, who was also a scientist, was a powerful figure from the 15th century.





Gordon Ramsay

From engineer apprentice to F1 team boss, Brawn is currently the team principal of Mercedes GP F1 team.






Sir Alex Ferguson
