Word	Definition	In context
present	Introduce some facts.	The students presented their finished books to the rest of the group.
collaborate	To work together or with someone else for a special purpose.	The group collaborated on a project with another school for the Worcester Show.
research	Investigate a topic.	The students researched Yayoi Kusama and Cornelia Parker by searching information on an Internet.
mental health	Mental health is about how we think, feel and act. Just like physical health, we all have it and we need to take care of it.	People's mental health can affect their judgement and interactions with each other.
discuss	Talk about a topic with other people.	It is important that we discuss mental health more openly.
3D	three dimensional	The students made a 3D model of the plant which could be viewed from all sides.
explore	Examine a topic in detail.	The students explored how Kasama and Cornelia Parker felt about the natural world.
Cornelia Parker visual artist	She engages with important issues of our time, be it violence, ecology or human rights.	Cornelia Parker reshapes everyday objects to make us question our relationship with the world.
installation	Put something, for example an artwork in a specific place.	The art installation took pride of place in front of the academy.
contemporary	belonging or occurring in the present	Cornelia Parker is a contemporary visual artist.
