# Academy Uniform

Tudor Grange Academy is very proud of the standards it maintains with uniform. This is achieved through the partnership between the Academy and home. To enable you to support the Academy the full uniform requirements are listed in this guide.

Tudor Grange Academy bespoke School Uniform and Monkhouse Schoolwear supply PE kit – a well-established and experienced supplier of School Uniform and PE kit.

All items of uniform are of a high quality, hard wearing and offer excellent value for money.

To ensure that your son/daughter complies with our uniform requirements we would recommend that it be purchased through Monkhouse Schoolwear from either the retail shop or are placed online via the Monkhouse Schoolwear website (<https://www.monkhouse.com/>).

## Blazer

Green with gold braiding and Academy badge on pocket, single breasted, two-button blazer.

## Tie

Official Tudor Grange tie, reaching the waist. Ties should not be tucked into shirts, and must be worn showing seven stripes.

Year 11 have a bottle green tie with school badge.

## Pullover, Sleeveless or Long Sleeved

Sleeveless or Long Sleeved V neck, mid grey. Light grey or black are not permitted. The pullover is optional to wear throughout the year. We recommend students wear these through HT2, HT3 and HT4 for additional warmth.

Round-necked jumpers, hoodies and sweatshirts are not permitted

### **Compulsory PE kit:**

Black/green with logo – Haze Ladies Fit Polo Shirt or Vapour Polo Shirt

Black / green ProTec Rugby Shirt or Black Hooded top with TGAW logo

Black cuatro shorts or black sports shorts or plain black skort

Black/bottle green sports socks with TGA letters

White trainer socks

Trainers

Outdoor trainers or football boots

### **Trainers for PE:**

Trainers with suitable support for sports and physical activity are required for PE lessons. It is advisable to have studded boots for sports taking place on the school field, such as football and rugby. Canvas style trainers and plimsoles are not suitable footwear for PE lessons.

### **Optional PE kit:**

Black/white – Cuatro Track Pants Black or Black tracksuit bottoms

Base layer Top (highly recommended for outdoor PE in winter)

Plain black – Plain sports leggings (no large logos)

Shin pads (advised for football and hockey)

Gum shield (advised for rugby)

Students are required to attend all PE lessons with the correct PE kit. The only time PE kit should not be worn by a student is if they have an approved medical reason or religious observation that forbids or restricts them from getting changed.

This should be clearly explained in a note from parents / guardians or through a phone call made to the school office.

# Academy PE Kit



## BAGS



**Bags should be black only** with no large logos. It is preferred that Yr 7 & Yr 8 have Academy bags

The following: non-bespoke Items can be purchased from the identified retailers OR from Monkhouse Schoolwear.

### Shirts

White buttoned shirt, which should be tucked in at all times.

### Trousers

Standard mid grey straight legged trousers are to be worn by boys and girls (unless they chose to wear a skirt). Tight fitting trousers, leggings, shorts, cargo pants or fashion trousers (skinnies) of any kind are not permitted in school. (Pictures of unacceptable trousers can be found on our website alongside a list of suggested stockists).

### Skirt

Grey pleated boxed skirt to be worn on or just above the knee. School togs have a wide range of sizes and lengths.

### Socks

Plain black or dark grey. Light, white patterned or knee length socks are not permitted.

Tights must not be worn with socks.

### Tights

Grey, plain/neutral or black tights are allowed for all years.

Patterned tights, leggings or socks worn with tights are not permitted.

### Shoes

Shoes should be plain black leather with a maximum heel height of 5cm and a maximum sole thickness of 2cm (the heel height is measured from the ground to the welt up the back of the heel).

Boots, boot-style shoes, stiletto heels, sling-back shoes, canvas shoes, suede shoes, trainers and skater style shoes are not permitted. Students wearing shoes that are not in keeping with the uniform code, will be asked to change into black pumps.

### Coats

We encourage pupils to wear coats in adverse weather conditions. Please do not wear coats with slogans on that could cause offence to others and please note that coats are not worn inside the school academy buildings. Pupils will be asked to remove them when entering. We do not allow denim jackets or hoodies to be worn as an alternative to coats.

### Academy Bag

A bag fit for the purpose of carrying school equipment, books and A4 folders. Small hand/shoulder bags and carrier bags are not allowed. Bags should be black only, it is preferred that year 7 & 8 have Academy bags purchased from School Togs. Small, subtle logos are permitted.

### Scarves and gloves

Scarves must be plain and must not be worn inside the Academy. Patterned scarves are not permitted.

### Hats

Hats, of any type, are not to be worn in or outside of the academy during academy hours. Unless in extreme weather, in which instance the school will communicate this to students and parents.

### Hairstyles:

Hairstyles should be kept in a smart fashion. Examples of hairstyles not permitted include; close shaved or skin-fade, decoratively shaved, lines in hair, extreme variations in length such as an undercut, two tone colouring, unnatural hair colouring, extensive highlighting and decorative braiding.

We support the halo code where students require specific styles in order to conform with racial or ethnic identity.

Hairbands, if worn, should be plain in colour; either bottle green, dark brown, dark grey or black (or colour of hair).

The Principal's decision on permitted hair styling is final.

### Jewellery:

Only watches may be worn. Students are not permitted to wear any other type of jewellery. Jewellery that is worn for religious reasons should be agreed upon with parents and the Principal.

### Make up:

A discreet amount of mascara is allowed. No other make-up, nail varnish or false nails are allowed.

False eyelashes and false nails are not permitted.

If a student arrives at school with incorrect uniform their College

Leader/member of SLT or the Principal may:

- (a) Send the student home to change, having first contacted the parents
- (b) Provide a change of uniform
- (c) Issued with penalties
- (d) Be set a college detention
- (e) Send the student to the isolation room to work for the day.

**The Principal's decision on acceptable uniform is final.**

# School Trouser & Skirt Guidance

The following information has been provided to help parents and carers in identifying what styles of trousers and skirts are suitable for school wear.

Our Uniform Policy clearly stipulates that tight fitting trousers, leggings, shorts, cargo pant or fashion trousers of any kind are not permitted in school.

Whilst this is not designed to be an exhaustive list, and bearing in mind that shop stock and styles will change, we hope that this guidance will be useful when purchasing school uniform items for your child.

## Acceptable Footwear

Shoes should be plain black leather with a maximum heel height of 5cm and a maximum sole thickness of 2cm (the heel height is measured from the ground to the welt up the back of the heel).



## Unacceptable Footwear

Boots, boot-style shoes, stiletto heels, sling-back shoes, canvas shoes, suede shoes, trainers and skater style shoes are not permitted. Students wearing shoes that are not in keeping with the uniform code, will be asked to change into black pumps.
